Membership

I remember being in school and having a Members Only jacket. I thought I was cool having one. Now those jackets seem to be making a comeback. There are ads calling them classic and iconic. If only I still had mine, perhaps my kids would think I was cool again... but probably not.

There is something that feels good about being a member of a group or organization. It makes us feel special or important. When Erica and I took classes to get our motorcycle licenses, I remember the one instructor telling us we were now part of the motorcycle brotherhood/sisterhood. Watch motorcyclists meeting each other on the road and you can see the wave of recognition between them.

With this seemingly inherent human desire to belong, what does it mean to be a member of a congregation? Does it assure us of a spot in the church cemetery upon our death? No. We have a cemetery open to the community. Does it assure us of a better seat in worship (which apparently is a back pew)? No. There is no reserved seating. Does it assure us of our salvation? No. That is something beyond human recordkeeping that only God can provide. Then what does it benefit us to be members of a congregation?

I remember hearing a colleague say years ago that the goal of his ministry was not gaining members within the congregation but cultivating a culture of discipleship. Those are my words, but in essence, that's what he was saying, and I agree with him. Membership cannot be the end goal of a congregation, it needs to be furthering the kingdom of God through the congregation's discipleship and living out the gospel. Where membership plays a role is in keeping track of the disciples within the worshipping community to better track the gifts and resources of the members, and to be sure no one slips through the cracks and is forgotten.

Membership means being part of the body of Christ and sharing in the ministry, not just having our names on a roster. What does it benefit us? We get to share our joys and sorrows, our celebrations and heartaches, and recognize that we are not alone on this journey of life. We can share in all that God has provided for us – ourselves, our times, our resources – and be part of something bigger than ourselves that brings hope, grace, and peace into this world.

To better serve members of this congregation, we will be sifting through the roles of the membership in the coming months and reaching out to those with whom we have lost contact. The goal is not to remove inactive members, but to be sure that people within our congregation know they are important within this part of the body of Christ and are being cared for. One of the results of this process may be that some members are removed from the roles because they are worshipping in another faith community, have no desire to be a part of this congregation, perhaps have moved out of the area, or some other reason we haven't considered.

Our constitution states that an active member is someone who has communed or made a contribution of record to the congregation within the current or preceding year. My encouragement to you is that you fill out a communion card or make a contribution of record each year to be sure to keep the membership current. If you haven't done so yet this year, please do so before the end of 2024. This will allow us to keep the records up to date and better support one another in life and ministry.

And if you happen to come across a Members Only jacket, let me know. Maybe I can borrow it and impress my kids!
