### **Fermenting Our Faith**

I am not much of an alcohol drinker. Once in a great while I will have a beer at a restaurant with my meal or at a family gathering. The only wine I drink is at communion, and even then it's only the little bit at the bottom of the chalice at Dinkey (at St. John's I have grape

juice). I know several people that have made their own beer and/or wine, but it's just not something I have taken much interest in.

What I do find intriguing is the process of making alcohol. Fermentation is a necessary part of the process, and is defined, according to Encyclopedia Brittanica, as "the chemical process by which molecules such as glucose are broken



down anaerobically" (existing in the absence of free oxygen). This "breaking down" is important, because every time you break something down energy is released.

We all have questions when it comes to faith, all we need is a place to ask them and explore them. On Wednesday, September 11, I'd like to use this concept of fermentation when it comes to our faith. That evening from 7:00-9:00PM, we have a space reserved for a group to gather, eat, perhaps partake of some beverages, and talk about our faith. Our hope is that by gathering in this relaxed atmosphere we can more freely explore the deeper questions of faith without feeling as guarded.

By asking having this discussion and breaking down our faith, my hope is that there is an energy released through this process similar to that of fermentation - an energy that will inspire us to keep asking questions, exploring, and then living out our faith in our daily lives. The one difference from the fermentation process I hope for, is that although fermentation lacks oxygen, may we be filled with the life-giving breath of God inspiring and invigorating each us through this process. I look forward to seeing you, if not before, on September 11.


