FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Transitions

I removed the air conditioner from my office at Dinkey and the mini-split in my office at St. John's has been switched from A/C to heat. The leaves have changed and are falling. Pools have been covered. We have definitely transitioned into autumn.

I say I like change and enjoy new things, but if I'm honest, I struggle when it comes to transitions. Whether it's seasonal transitions, or personal ones like the start or end of a school year for Erica and our children, I have a hard time adjusting to something new – even if it's familiar. These seasonal transitions come around every year. I know they are coming. Yet, there are times I just don't feel prepared for what is coming next.

We are about to encounter a major transition in our church and worship life. On Sunday, November 24, we will be celebrating Christ the King, Christ's triumphant return. The entire church year culminates to this one day of celebration of Christ as Lord of all. Throughout summer and into fall we have been hearing stories from the Bible about the growth of God's people through the teachings of Jesus and the gift of the Spirit. Now on this last Sunday of the church calendar year we celebrate Jesus' rightful place on the right hand of God. What happens between Christ the King and the following Sunday is where the real transition takes place

Sunday, December 1, will be the First Sunday of Advent. It's the start of a new church year. We'll go from a celebration of Jesus as Lord of all to looking in expectation to the inbreaking of God in our lives through the living Word. Talk about a transition! On top of that, we will be changing the look of our worship spaces. The blue paraments will adorn the altar, pulpit, and lectern. The greens will be placed around the sanctuary, and the advent wreath will be lit as we watch God's light grow each Sunday.

But as with any transition, we need something that is constant and sure, something we know we can rely upon. I pray that God may be that consistent presence for you. It doesn't matter if we are celebrating Christ the King or the First Sunday of Advent, the most important part of it all is God's never-ending steadfast love.

Whatever transitions you may be encountering in your life, whether they are seasonal, temporary, permanent, life changing, or just a blip in the big picture, may your foundation and base be the love God is constantly pouring upon you. May you feel God's presence and be secure in whatever you are encountering and embrace your transition with expectation and joy.


