FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Ioint Worship

I have been absolutely enjoying the midweek Lenten worship series with our cohort of five local congregations: St. John's, Dinkey Memorial, Ben Salem, Zion Stone, and St. Peter's. It's not just the food after worship that I enjoy, although I must admit I love the unspoken challenge between the congregations to have the best food! I truly appreciate working with the other pastors, getting to know people in the other congregations, hearing about each other's ministries, and sharing our insights and resources.

For instance, Dinkey recently approved upgrades to the audio, video, and streaming system in the congregation and Zion Stone was helpful in that process. A small group went to Zion Stone to see their system and discuss how it evolved oner the years. That sharing of resources and experience helped to make the process a much smoother one than it would have been without it.

When it comes to the pastors, I appreciate the collegiality we share with one another. We share our challenges and celebrations. We provide coverage for one another when one of us is on vacation or needs some help. We also help each other not to take ourselves too seriously, joking and laughing with one another.

But perhaps what I most appreciate with these midweek Lenten services is the fact that we are crossing denominational boundaries. Dinkey and St. John's are Lutheran while Ben Salem, St. Peter's, and Zion Stone are UCC. This is not about promoting our own brands, but about celebrating God's gift of grace showered upon all people no matter their denominational background.

This unity we have with one another is not dependent upon uniformity. We come together with our different gifts and celebrate as one. One congregation may have a great choir, another bells or chimes. There are bazaars and bake sales, youth events and vacation Bible schools. Some may even have a pastor that is younger than the other three! (Sorry, I had to slip that one in there.)

The point is that these five different congregations share a commonality which is more important than any of our differences and is at the very core of what binds us together: we are all dependent upon God's grace. If you have not yet joined us this Lent, I encourage you to come to one of our remaining Lenten services and see how God is at work sharing grace for all.
