The Need for Faith & Community - Part 2

It's Wednesday morning and Claudia just finished in 2nd place in her cross country race last night. That's something I could not have imagined writing a few months ago. Back in the May newsletter I shared how appreciative we as a family were for all the support we received during Claudia's bout with parvovirus. She could barely walk, let alone run a race. When we

went to watch Erica run the Boston Marathon on April 15, I was literally carrying her around the city because she didn't have the strength to make it on her own. So, it brings me joy I can hardly contain to see her out on the courses this season running her heart out. The hopelessness Erica and I felt when she was ill has been replaced with gratitude and appreciation.



The journey to where we are now was not easy. We leaned hard on one another, our families, and our church families. It meant a great deal to us whenever one of you would ask how Claudia was doing or tell us she was in your prayers. The schoolteachers and staff were tremendous. They worked with Claudia to help her complete class requirements, and even provided her the opportunity to rest in the nurse's office each day. The medical personnel were compassionate, not only with Claudia but with her mother and I knowing we were stressed in wanting our daughter to be healthy again.

As I stated in May, this virus was bigger than us and we needed to put our faith in a God bigger than the virus – and, boy, did God provide. Through all the instances mentioned above, God was reaching out to let us know we weren't alone. I don't believe God made our daughter sick to test us or teach us anything. But I do think God was constantly working through all of you to support and encourage us. Together you truly were the Body of Christ for us when we most needed it. On behalf of my family, I thank you so very much for your loving support. We cannot fully express our gratitude to each and every one of you.

If you are experiencing challenges or hardships, I pray you may feel the love and support of God through this community of faith. Know that God is walking with you to provide for you the grace and compassion you need in whatever you face. And may we all be conduits of that love of God for one another.

Pork & Beans


